



### **LESSON**

#### DON'T FOCUS ON SYMBOLS INSTEAD OF THE REAL THING

In the Bible, there are many symbols and shadows of Jesus.

For example, the cross. We identify that as a symbol of Jesus. People wear it as jewellery. Even rappers wear them. So do vampire fighters. But the cross in itself is just a symbol. It has no power. <u>The cross is not Jesus</u>.

The Israelites thought that as long as they had the Ark of the Covenant, God was with them. So they brought it to the battlefront ... and lost the battle, and the Ark.

#### GOD HAS NEVER LEFT US NOR FORSAKE US

When the Israelites turned to "the real thing", God gave them victory over the Philistines by causing confusion among enemy.

To commemorate the victory, Samuel the prophet took a big stone and set it up, calling it *Ebenezer*, which means, "Thus far the Lord has helped us."

#### **MILESTONES**

In our journey of life, there are ups and downs, happy times and sad times, good times and bad times. Certain events and incidences may stand out for us and leave a lasting impression. Through it all ... God never leaves us nor forsake us.


We need to remember these times. Like the Israelites, we need to set up milestones to help us remember all the good things God has done for us. We can also look back and say, "Thus far the Lord has helped us!"


### **ACTIVITY SUGGESTIONS**

#### **HUDDLE TIME: PERSONAL MILESTONES**


